Do a T-CLOCS to make sure your tires are aired up to the recommended pressures, the fluids are all filled, and everything is in working order. Also don't forget about checking your riding gear over.

Don't put off doing maintenance on your bike. I know we hate having to do it sometimes, but it keeps you from having to walk home.

Remember people in cars aren't used to seeing bikes on the road after winter so ride defensively.

It's also a good time to think about taking a riding class to refresh or sharpen your skills. If you don't use it you lose it.

With the hot weather make sure you drink plenty of water and stay hydrated.
